Literacy - Spelling

You could also write sentences for the words. paint the words, write outside in chalk, make with playdough, cut letters out of newspaper, use magnetic letters. Find other words with the same sound and learn how to write these correctly.

Choose 2 words from each and write a sentence for them.

Numeracy and Maths

Addition and Subtraction Ask someone in your family to write out 20 sums.

Whichever level you can do.

Ask the adult to time how long it takes you to complete.

Solve the mystery of the missing vegetables. This activity has different maths word problems.


