Parental Engagement

Engaging with parents and carers is crucial to raising attainment and ensuring that all children feel supported and progress in their learning. Below is an update on some improvements and changes that have recently been undertaken as a result of self-evaluation and improvement work involving parents and carers.

Family Learning Workshops

Following very positive feedback from parents, carers, children and staff we have continued our Family Learning Workshops. Workshops are being held for each class and are a great opportunity for parents and children to work together on different aspects of literacy and numeracy. Parents have told us that the workshops have also helped with supporting learning at home. Dates for some classes' workshops are listed above. Other dates will be noted on the school app.



Parent Consultations

Our second Parent Consultation event takes place on Wednesday 18th March 6pm-8.30pm and Thursday 19th March 3.30pm -6pm. Request for appointments will be sent out over the next few weeks.

Children will also be bringing home their Snapshot Jotters this term so you can discuss your child's learning with them at home too.

Parent Reps Meeting

Our first Parent Reps meeting took place last term and focused on our School Improvement Plan. Each Parent Rep worked closely with a small group of children as they discussed the progress being made with improvements for this session so far. Each group of children confidently discussed the learning taking place in their classrooms and suggested next steps too. The feedback is going to be displayed in the school for everyone to see as we progress through the rest of the year.

Coffee and Catch Up Meeting

Useful information

Nut-free School

To protect children who have a severe food allergy to peanuts/nuts, it is important that there is strict avoidance to this food in order to prevent a life-threatening allergic reaction. Any exposure to peanuts/nuts may cause a life-threatening allergic reaction that requires emergency medical treatment. To reduce the chance of this occurring, we are asking that you do not send any peanut or nut containing products to school with your child that will be eaten in school.

School Car Park Safety

Can we remind parents that the school car park is for the use of staff and visitors to the school. **We would respectfully ask all other parents not to use the school car park.** It is not safe to drop your child off in the car park in the morning due to the number of cars and taxis accessing this facility. Many thanks for helping to ensure the safety of all our children.



It is important for your child to stay hydrated at school. Please can they come to school each day with a named water bottle. They can top up at our water fountain. Water bottles are available from the school office for £1.

Playtime Snack – You can provide your child with a small, nut-free, snack to have at playtime if you wish to do so. The school office, however, does not have the facility to provide snack if your child does not have one. Thank you for your support with this matter.

Reducing Illness in School

To reduce the impact of the spread of illness in school for pupils and staff please can you adhere to the following:

- A child **must not** return to school for 48 hours after their last bout of sickness or diarrhea.
Any child returning to school before this will be sent home.
- Encourage your children if they have a cough to cough into the crease of their elbow and not their hands.

Encourage your child to wash their hands after going to the toilet. We request this in school in addition to the use of hand gel in every classroom.
