

Spanish Vocabulary

- The letter n with a symbol above it – ñ is pronounced like the n in onion.
- The letter J has the same sound as ch in loch.
- The letter c followed by e or i has the same sound as th in think.
- The letter c followed by a o or u has the same sound as c in car.
- The letter v is pronounced as a b.
- The letter z has the same sound as th in think.
- Any accents in Spanish tell you to emphasise that syllable in a word.
- You pronounce all the letters in a word in Spanish except H which is silent.
