Children Learning: Our new learning context is AMAZING ME! This came about after staff have been observing the children and are noticing we lot of role play, dancing and creative play so some of the children helped choose the book GIRAFFES CAN'T DANCE by Giles Andreae. This book focuses on Gerald the Giraffe who wants to join in with the other animals at the Jungle Dance but everyone knows Giraffes can't dance...or can they? It's a triumphant story that's looks at building

confidence and resilience and its ok to be different. We will be exploring lots of different music genres, how to dance to different music and experimenting

with rhyme, music, dance and drama, so look out for a big show in the future!
