Your school grounds and daily routine





This is the special Primary 1 playground, in the morning your parents or carers will drop you off here. When the bell rings we line up and the class teachers come and lead us into the cloakroom. In the cloakroom you take off your jacket, hang up your bags and, if you have a packed lunch, you place it in the packed lunch boxes area.



This is the Multi-court area, sometimes we will have PE sessions here or in the same hall we have lunch.

At playtime the Support for Learning Assistants (SLA's) will lead you to the playground. If it is raining a bell will ring 5 times to let us know and then we get to play in the classroom.

At lunch time your teacher will ask you to line up and take you through to the lunch hall. They will help you pick your lunch that you choose that morning.

Some older boys and girls have a special job – they are called Lunchtime Leaders – and they are there to help you to choose salad and dessert and to put away your trays when you are finished.

The SLA's, Mr Hill and Mrs Smith will all be in the lunch hall if you need help to cut your food or open any packets or juice for your lunch. When you are finished your lunch, the SLA's will take you outside for a play in the playground.

At the end of day your class teacher will help you get ready with your jacket, school bag and water bottle before saying goodbye and your parents/ carers will be waiting to collect you from the playground.
