# **PE Kit**

Thank you for your continued support in ensuring that your child wears the correct PE Kit. Please ensure your children's clothing is labelled.

#### PE uniform consists of:

- black or white trainers
- plain white T-shirt
- Black/navy leggings, tracksuit bottoms or shorts

**PE Safety** - A wee reminder that children will be asked to remove or cover earrings before taking part in PE sessions. This is to avoid injury with earrings during physical activity with others. If you wish your child to cover stud earrings then please provide tape (micropore tape works well) and staff can help with this in class as required. If your child wears hoop earrings please show your child how to remove these before participating in PE.

If you require support regarding school uniform then please contact the school office who will be happy to support.

# Lost Property

We continue to gather large numbers of jackets, jumpers and cardigans within our lost property area. We will return named clothing to their owner but many items do not have a name or have the name of a child who has passed their clothing on.

Can I ask you to ensure all clothing is labelled and if you think an item may be stored in our lost property please let us know. Lost property is stored in the Janitor's office.

Unclaimed lost property will be added to our pre-loved bank of uniforms or to the Rag Bag on a termly basis.

# <u>Safeguarding</u>

As this is the first newsletter of the year I wanted to highlight to our families that we have a well established system for safeguarding children in our school and nursery. Safeguarding is one of our Statutory duties. It's all of our jobs to make sure we safeguard children in school but we have key leads on this matter who are responsible for coordinating that safeguarding. These key individuals are Mark Hill (Head Teacher), Danielle Smith (DHT) and Toni Swain (Nursery Principal).

On the first INSET of any school year, staff all receive training regarding safeguarding and child protection and are briefed on our system and how to report concerns. This could be a child disclosing something to them, which would mean they are potentially at harm or they feel that a child in their care is failing to thrive.
