Here are some reasons why:


- people leave and join your school

- sometimes, because of the number of children at your school, you may be in a composite class - when 2 or more stages are together.



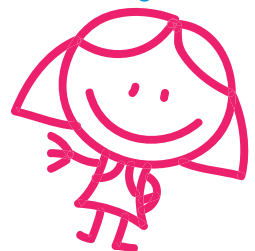
"I think I will lose my friends... and I will miss them."

"I felt kind of happy and kind of sad."



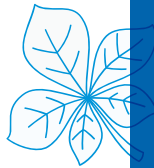
Make lots more friends and be happy!

"It's good to be in a composite class because you can make new friends and mix with different age groups."



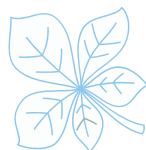

"The teachers know what you have to learn whatever class you are in and help us to make other friends in the new class too."

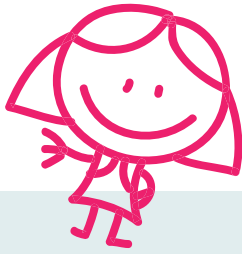


Moving class can be exciting. Remember, you are not alone!
