

Unacceptable Behaviour

4. If a pupil continues to not follow the teacher's direction and school values they will have time out within another class. This will be recorded as a blue in home school diary and shared with parents.

5. If this continues during time out or returning back to class then SMT will be sent for, the child will discuss and reflect on their actions with the member of staff and parents will be informed.



Playtimes and Lunchtimes

1. The playground helpers will remind the pupils of the school values and expected behaviour.

2. If the child chooses not to follow the school values/expected behaviour then they will receive a red traffic light and this will be included in homework diaries for parents to see. Pupils will lose 5 minutes of their Fantastic Friday.

3. If a child receives 3 red traffic lights in a week then parents will be called by SMT.

Swearing will not be tolerated. If any child is heard the following will be followed.

The first time—Parents will be told by SMT.

Second time—A letter will be posted home.

Third time—A meeting will be held with the SMT and parents.

Unacceptable Behaviour

If pupils don't follow our school values in class you will...

1. Be given a verbal warning and choices. If they follow the teachers directions and show the school values they will return to the green traffic light.
2. Moved to the amber traffic light If they follow your teacher's direction and show the values again they can return to the green colour on the traffic lights.

3. If they continue to not follow the teacher's direction/ display the school values their name will be moved onto the red traffic light and can not be moved. You will lose 5 minutes of your Fantastic Friday. This will be recorded in your home school diary for parents to look at and sign.
