### Available to current S4 pupils:

### **Foundation Apprenticeships**

- this is a **2 year course**  $\rightarrow$  Monday and Wednesday afternoon you will be college students or workers
- you can change into college appropriate clothing before leaving for college
- check entry requirements (most ask for 2 Highers by end of S6) <a href="https://www.forthvalley.ac.uk/ways-to-study/foundation-apprenticeships/">https://www.forthvalley.ac.uk/ways-to-study/foundation-apprenticeships/</a>
- work-based learning opportunity  $\rightarrow$  spend time with local employers on a work experience placement (which is organised by College)
- gain an industry recognised **Level 6 qualification** at college while you also complete your other subjects like National 5s and Highers at school. This is equivalent to a level 6 (Higher) with no SQA exam.
- leads straight into a job, further study at college or university, or a fast-track Modern Apprenticeship.
- choose as one of your course choices  $\rightarrow$  you also need to do an ONLINE application form to the FA
- **no transport costs** to pupils a minibus will be provided to take you to FVC or a Stirling School on a Monday and Wednesday afternoon.

- The transport must leave sharp at 9am you must arrive at reception by 8.50am
- Transport will pick you up at 2.15pm at Stirling Campus and will bring you back to school so you can attend period 6. **Pupils cannot opt to stay in Stirling**
- You must <u>catch up with class work missed</u> while at College on a Friday between periods 1-5
