Dear Parents and Carers,

We extend a warm welcome to 4 new pupils and a returning pupil. Our current school role is 137 pupils across the 6 classes.

I hope families had a chance for some rest and relaxation time over the festive season. Getting back into a routine can be a challenge. We appreciate the effort made to arrive at school on time in the morning as this helps pupils to settle into class and ensures the smooth running of taking registers, lunch choices and starting learning. We understand that occasionally things can crop up that can delay arriving at school on time, in which case children will need come to the main door rather than coming in with their class line. Some mornings we can have up to 20 children coming in late through the main door. Thank you in anticipation of your support to reduce the amount of latecoming in future.

Scots Poetry Competition and Burns Celebrations

Thursday 25th January

P7s will host a Burns Supper in the school hall at 2pm for 2 guests per pupil and also some invited guests from the village who have been volunteering at whist sessions in school. P7 and Miss MacInnes have all been working hard to prepare for this special event.

Friday 26th January

We will have the finals of the Burns Poetry Competition in school on Friday 26th January with our guest judge Mrs Oswald. The 5 finalists from each year group in P3-7 and the P1 and P2 groups will all recite their poems. This event is for pupils only.

Friday 2nd February

We will have a celebration for parents/carers/families in the hall where the 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} place from the poetry competition will recite their poems and P1 and P2 groups will also recite their poems. We will put out slips on Friday 26^{th} January to get an idea of numbers attending.

Pupils are welcome to wear tartan on any of the Scots/Burns celebration days. Well done to all pupils for the effort and enthusiasm that is being put into learning their poems. We appreciate the support from home to help with learning their words.

P4-7 School Show

Pupils from P4-7 will be performing Treasure Island in Kippen Village Hall on 20th and 21st March at 6pm. P6 and P7 pupils will take on the main parts, which will be allocated following auditions next month. P4 and P5 pupils will be part of the chorus.

Railing Repair Update

An update on where we are with the repairs for the railings by the bottom playground. I am waiting for a second quote as per the Council's required process for tendering for major repairs. The first quote is £3,800 plus the additional cost of repointing the wall, and could be done during the Easter holidays when school is not in attendance and the weather is potentially more favourable. Our annual planned repairs budget is £1920 so the wall and railing repair will use up more than one year's budget allocation, but is an essential spend due to the poor condition of the railings.
