You can collect any data you like e.g. types of birds you can see in your garden, types of trees or plants you see on a walk, types of toys you have in your house. Can you put this data in a pictogram? A grown up may need to help you with the layout.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Keep practicing the sounds in your sound tub.Make some words with the sounds in your tub. Blend the sounds together to read the words.Keep practicing the sight words in your tub.This week at school we will be discussing our favourite book characters. Who is your favourite book character? Which story are they in? Why are they your favourite? Can you draw a picture of them or write about them?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">We have been learning about hibernating animals. Can you name some? Where do you think they would like to hibernate? Can you make a home for them in your garden?PE/ literacy- write some sounds on pieces of paper (one sound on each piece of paper and make sure you write them BIG so you can see them from a distance). Place the sounds spread out around your garden. Ask a grown up to say a sound, run to that sound as fast as you can. Repeat as many times as you like. Challenge- ask the grown up to say a word, run to the initial, middle or final sound in that word.
