<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If you have an advent calendar; count how many doors are open and how many are closed each day. Ask a grown up to point to the number on one of the doors, can you tell them the number before and after that number?</li><li>• Challenge- can you tell a grown up the numbers that are 'two more' and 'two less' than some of the numbers on your advent calendar?</li><li>• We have started to learn about 3D shapes. Can you identify cubes, cuboids, spheres, cylinders and cones in your house?</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Keep practicing the sounds in your sound tub.</li><li>• Make some words with the sounds in your tub.</li><li>• You will get two reading books home this week. One on Monday and one on Wednesday. Please keep each book for a week, bringing it back the following Monday/ Wednesday.</li><li>• Clap out the syllables in these winter words- snowflake, Christmas tree, mistletoe, Santa, advent calendar. Can you identify the initial sounds in these words?</li><li>• Challenge- Can you say/ write a sentence using some of the winter words?</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• We have been learning about internet safety. Please talk to your child about how to stay safe when using computers, ipads, phones etc. For example: Not sharing their personal information (name, address, school) online. Telling a grown up if they see anything that worries/ scares them online.
