Breakfast Club

Our breakfast club operates from the dining hall each morning from 8.15am-8.45am. This provision is **free** for all pupils.

Home Learning Club

Our lunchtime home learning club will begin again after the September break. This will allow our children (and you!) time to become familiar with the new home learning format. Children requiring support with home learning activities will be identified by their teachers.

EE2s / Contact Details

You will receive an EE2 form to complete about your child. This ensures we hold up to date medical information and is required to be updated annually. Please return this as soon as possible.

Also, please ensure that we hold up to date contact details, including emergency contact numbers. This is extremely important so that we can contact you quickly in case of an emergency.

<u>Uniform</u>

We value the support of our parents / carers in encouraging all pupils in the wearing of school uniform. It is important that our children take pride in their school and attending in uniform is a vital part in building the ethos of our school.

Pupil Absences

A reminder that you must notify the school office of your child's absence by 9.30am. This allows us to ensure that all of our children are safe.

House Badges

Primary 1 children will be issued with their house badges in the next few weeks. Children in P2-P7 who have lost their badge can purchase a new one from the school office for £1. Please encourage your child to wear their badge!



<u>Equipment</u>
