## **Internet Safety**

- \* Safe networking sites should have the CEOP (Child Exploitation Online Protection) button CEOP REPORT
- \* We continue to educate our children on safe use of the internet and use clips from www.thinkuknow.com or CEOP videos from <a href="https://www.youtube.com">www.youtube.com</a> to highlight the importance of internet safety.

We continually emphasise responsible use of the internet in school and work closely with PC Arnott in delivering a consistent message to our children.

# **Bus Provision**

As you are aware, a bus service operates to and from school from the Belvedere area and Boghall. It is a parental choice to use this service as the school does not provide any supervision on the bus. We do use our support staff to support the younger children going on to the bus at the end of the school day. If you have a child in P1-P3, please send a note to the class teacher advising them if your child will be using the bus so that arrangements can be made to ensure they get on the bus. Choir - The school choir has been showcasing its talent over the festive period. The children were a credit to this school, their families and to themselves! Choir rehearsals are suspended until 21st March.


