Outdoor Learning - This month we are ...



- Looking at the changes in Autumn in the local environment.
- Looking after local wildlife, feeding the ducks and squirrels as the weather gets colder.
- Learning about what we need to wear to go out in various Autumn / Winter weather conditions.
- Going to spend time playing and exploring the local woodland.

Literacy - This month we will be ...



- Practising lots of nursery rhymes.
- Listening to identify sounds e.g. clap, stamp, finger click, instrument sounds and environmental sounds.
- Listening and identifying loud and quiet sounds.
- Listening to and copying sound patterns.

Numeracy - This month we will be ...



- Practising counting forwards to and backwards from 20.
- Starting counting from various numbers.
- Making numbers with our fingers in lots of ways.
- Identifying dice and dot patterns up to 10.
- Using fingers to keep count of claps, drum beats etc.
