Writing



The dragon came last night to my house and told me that Fairyland is nearly rebuilt. Well done boys and girls! The rebuilding has gone so well that there is extra space in the land with no-one living there! Can you help? Make up your own Fairytale character. It could be a prince, princess, animal, dragon etc...

Write a story about your character. This is a Fairy tale so should start with 'Once upon a time...' and finish with 'They lived happily ever after.'

Write the story in 3 sections. Firstly, draw a picture of your character in the place they live. Then write underneath what happens at the start of the story.

Then move onto the middle section. Draw a picture first, talk about what happens and then write. Repeat for the end.

Remember capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and to sound out each word as best you can.

It might be a good idea to complete this writing over a number of days E.g.

Day 1- choose a character and draw a picture of them.

Day 2- Draw and write the beginning

Day 3- Draw and write the middle

Day 4- Draw and write the end and self assess using core target sheet.
