

It will help you practise time durations on a digital clock.</p> <p>Can you write the digital times to show:</p> <p><u>1 hour later</u> than these times: 3.00, 9.00, 4.00</p> <p><u>1 hour earlier</u> than these times: 2.00, 5.00, 6.00</p>	<p>Write a sentence for each of your spelling words (You might want to do this across 3 days as there are 3 sounds.)</p> <p>-pray, day, play, stay hair, rain, train, brain cake, came, name, sale</p>	<p>Months of the year</p> <p>Ask an adult to write down the 12 months of the year on a piece of paper/ recycled card from cereal boxes etc. Can you put them in the correct order?
