<p>Use a book in the house or online and see if you can find a word for every letter in the alphabet. This is a good way to improve your skimming and scanning skills. Write the words in your jotter.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Time</p> <p>Look at the attached Powerpoint lesson on Time Duration. It will help you practise time durations on an analogue clock. Can you write the digital times to show: <u>1 hour later</u> than these times: 3.00, 9.00, 4.00 <u>2 hours later</u> than these times 1.00, 10.00, 12.00 <u>1 hour earlier</u> than these times: 2.00, 5.00, 6.00</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Money</p> <p>Ask an adult to think of an amount up to 50p (or £1 for a challenge). With a bundle of coins, see how many different ways you can count out that amount and write down the coins you have used in your jotter. Don't forget to write the p after the amount! Repeat for a 5 different amounts.</p>
