In phonics we will be learning the sounds **g**, **l**, **f** and **o**. Practise writing these letters neatly and try to think of 2 things with each sound at the beginning. For example **g** is for gorilla and grass. Can you say these words as part of a sentence?



Numeracy

This week we are learning about addition. Using concrete materials (blocks, stones, marbles, lego pieces, pasta or anything else you have to hand) complete the following

sums:

$$3 + 4 =$$

$$2 + 5 =$$

$$6 + 2 =$$

$$1 + 3 =$$

$$7 + 2 =$$

$$5 + 4 =$$

Count out two separate groups before finding the answer. For example for 3+4, count out 3 blocks. Then count out 4 blocks. Now find how many there are altogether.

Science

In science we have been learning about what makes things living or non-living. Can you point out things which are living and non-living either in your house or outside?

Remember living things will grow, eat and breathe.
