Spike's Frogs and Toads March 2020

Secondly, let's help frogs and toads to survive by building them a habitat outside.

You will need

- A gardening spade or fork
- large stones/ small rocks
- sticks of different sizes
- fallen leaves and foliage



Method

- 1. Choose a suitable location to build your frog or toad habitat.
- 2. Dig a hole in the soil using your gardening spade or fork.
- Place your stones & rocks on the bottom of your hole so any water can drain on the bottom of your frog/ toad habitat.
- 4. Place the longer/ bigger sticks over the top of your hole first in a criss-cross (waffle-like) pattern.
- 5. Keep building more sticks over the top, decreasing in size.
- 6. Spread fallen leaves and foliage over the top of your sticks to make it camouflaged from predators.
- 7. Remember to leave a small entrance for the frogs and toads to get in and out.
- Ensure your sticks and foliage has not fallen into the hole. Your frog and toad home should have space inside for them to sleep.
