ICT - We are learning what coding is and how to can use it to create our own projects.

Interdisciplinary Learning:

Through a variety of contexts we'll be taught different curricular areas and will develop our skills for learning, for life and for work.

Each context will be led by 2 or 3 areas of the curriculum although there will be lots of opportunity to develop links across learning and to apply our reading and writing skills.

This term our topic is about the Scottish landscape and volcanoes. During this time we are also going to investigate Victorian Edinburgh and what a Victorian Christmas would have been like.

FYI

Outdoor PE Kit is required on a Tuesday and Thursday. It is important that the children have suitable kit on these days.

Outdoor Learning: Primary 5 will be going outdoors on a Monday afternoon. The children all have an individual set of waterproofs for their use provided by school.

Home learning this term will focus on improving our mental maths skills and reading.

The children will be assigned mental maths challenges via Teams each week. Each child also has a group reading book - the book must be kept at home till the last week of term. This is to reduce items being brought back and forth to school. The children have a class copy of the same book to use in school. The children will have an assigned amount of reading to complete each week - posted on Teams. There will also be a class activity to complete based on the reading for that week.
