SQUARE NUMBERS

- 1. What number multiplied by itself gives 4?
- 2. What number multiplied by itself gives 64?
- 3. What number multiplied by itself gives 100?
- **4.** What number multiplied by itself gives 9?

The square of the number 4 is 4 x 4 which equals 16.

The square of the number 7 is 7×7 which equals 49.

Another way of writing 'the square of the number 4' is 4^2

4² means 'four squared ' or 4 x 4.

5² means ' five squared ' or 5 x 5

Write down in words what these mean;

- **6.** 3^2
- **7**. 8² **8**. 2²
- **9.** 10^2 **10.** 9^2

The value of 3^2 is 3 x 3 which is 9.

What is the value of these:

- **11.** 4²
- **12.** 5^2 **13.** 2^2 **14.** 3^2
- **15.** 9²
- **16.** 1, 4, 9, 16, 25, 36, 49, 64, 81, 100 are all square numbers.
