Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club will begin on

Wednesday 12th August and will run
each morning from 8.00am. Children
will receive breakfast of toast or cereal
and a drink before going off to play.
Children must enter via designated
gates as identified in the attached
map. Members of staff will support
children coming into the building and
register them before they go off to
play.

Nursery Lunches

Full day children can purchase a meal from the school kitchen, alternatively you are welcome to provide your child with a packed lunch. Staff will support children during lunchtime.

Snack and Milk

Children will receive a snack along with a drink during the morning and afternoon session. This will be served and supervised by staff.

Belongings and Bags

Children should bring a bag to nursery with them every day. Please provide you child with a full set of fresh clothes in the event of a change being required. Your child must wear an outdoor jacket and suitable outdoor shoes. Where possible, please provide your child with wellie boots.

Face Masks

The national guidance suggests that children under 5 years of age do not require to wear face masks.

Dropping Off and Picking Up

It is essential that, whilst dropping children off or picking them up that all adults observe 2m physical distancing from other adults. To help with this, we have put 2m markers on the ground to indicate safe distance. We have also created a zoned area at each exit point so that there is a clear 2m between adults collecting children and staff. Please do not go beyond this line to ensure everyone's safety.

The nursery doors will open at 8.00am.

- ✓ Main door Purple and Orange Group
- ✓ Gate in the school playground into the garden Blue and Yellow Group
- ✓ Gate opposite indoor/outdoor area Red and Green Group

We are aware that separating may be difficult for some of our children, therefore it is important that we all work together to ensure that children feel safe and secure.

Nursery staff will advise you about drop off and collection times as these will be agreed to best meet the needs of individual children.

<u>Illness</u>



If your child becomes unwell in nursery and is displaying any of the COIVD-19 symptoms, they will immediately be taken to a safe area to keep them safe and comfortable and to limit their contact with others. We will contact you promptly to collect your child and will provide you with information about the test and protect service.
