Reading

1. Sketch the setting, one of the characters or an event from the passage.
Write details from the text around your sketch.
2. Choose three interesting words and write down what you think they mean.
Find the meaning of the word in a dictionary.
3. Make a prediction about what you think will happen next. Why do you think that? Is there evidence to support your idea?
4. Find and write down 5 verbs from your text.
5. Find and write down 5 adjectives from your text.

Writing Ideas: Recount

Watch the video then write a recount about it.

A recount is when you write about what happened.

- Write in the past tense
- Put the events in order
- Remember to write about who (character), when (when does it take place), where (where does it take place), what (what happens)
- Use time words (then, next, afterwards, in the morning, later, after that)
- Use verbs and adjectives to make your writing more interesting.

An alternative is to create a storyboard/ cartoon strip about the video and draw the different events in order.

Expressive Art: Romero Britto style flowers.

I thought we could use ideas from previous art lessons. Back in term 1 we looked at the artist Romero Britto and last week I gave you a link to draw some tulips.

This week we are going to combine the two.

You will need paper, pencil, black pen, coloured pens/ pencils.

(the video is for drawing a heart but you can apply the same technique with any style of drawing)

1. Use your pencil and draw a line near the bottom of the page for the grass
2. Draw some tulips
3. Draw lines on the background and tulips to divide it up.
4. Go over your lines with black pen
5. Within each part create a different pattern
6. Colour in each pattern.

Patterns: spots, hearts, flowers, stripes, diamonds, wavy lines, stars, zig zags, circles, curly lines, spirals, dotted lines.
