Writing - Write a Letter

Write a letter to your class teacher for next year. You can tell them about your family, what you enjoy doing (hobbies), any clubs that you go to and what you did during primary 3.

You might want to include:

- Any brothers, sisters or cousins you have
- Any activities you have done/ enjoyed play football, reading books, films you like
- Places you have visited holidays, shops, restaurants, other towns
- Clubs football, gymnastics, Taekwondo, swimming
- Your likes/ dislikes foods, music, books,
- Primary 3 topics, maths, and things you enjoyed/ did not.

I have included a letter writing diagram to show you how to set it out. Complete on a piece of paper.

<u>Maths - Place Value - partitioning numbers</u>

E.q. 54 = 50 + 4, 5 tens and 4 ones

735 = 700 + 30 + 5. 7 hundreds, 3 tens and 5 ones.

You do not need to print out the worksheets – you can write answers down on paper.

<u>Maths - Money</u> - adding up coins to calculate totals. Calculate change from an amount.
