



IMPORTANT: Seesaw Permission Slip

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to share with you that this school year our P1-3 classes will be using Seesaw (<http://seesaw.me>), a secure online journal where students can document and reflect on what they are learning in class. Your child will be able to add the things we work on (including photos, videos, worksheets, drawings and voice recordings) to their Seesaw journal and we can share them privately with you and other family members to view and comment on throughout the school year.

Our P4/3fccccff-7 pupils currently use TEAMS and See Saw would be for our P1-3 children.

For your child to use Seesaw, the app needs your child's first name only in order to be able to associate work like their photos, videos or voice recordings with their account. Seesaw only uses this information to provide the service and doesn't advertise in Seesaw, create profiles of students, or share or sell your child's personal information or journal content.
