




Spring



Spring is one of the four seasons. It comes after winter and before summer. March, April and May are the spring months.





During spring, new life begins for plants and animals. Lambs, chicks, butterflies and tadpoles are born. Many flowers begin to grow again in spring, such as daffodils, bluebells and crocuses.

Some trees have beautiful blossom during spring. They are often pink or white. Bees love to collect pollen from the blossom.

The hours of daylight increase during spring. By the end of spring it might even still be light outside when you are going to bed!



The weather in spring is varied. It can be sunny, windy, rainy, warm or even snowy!
