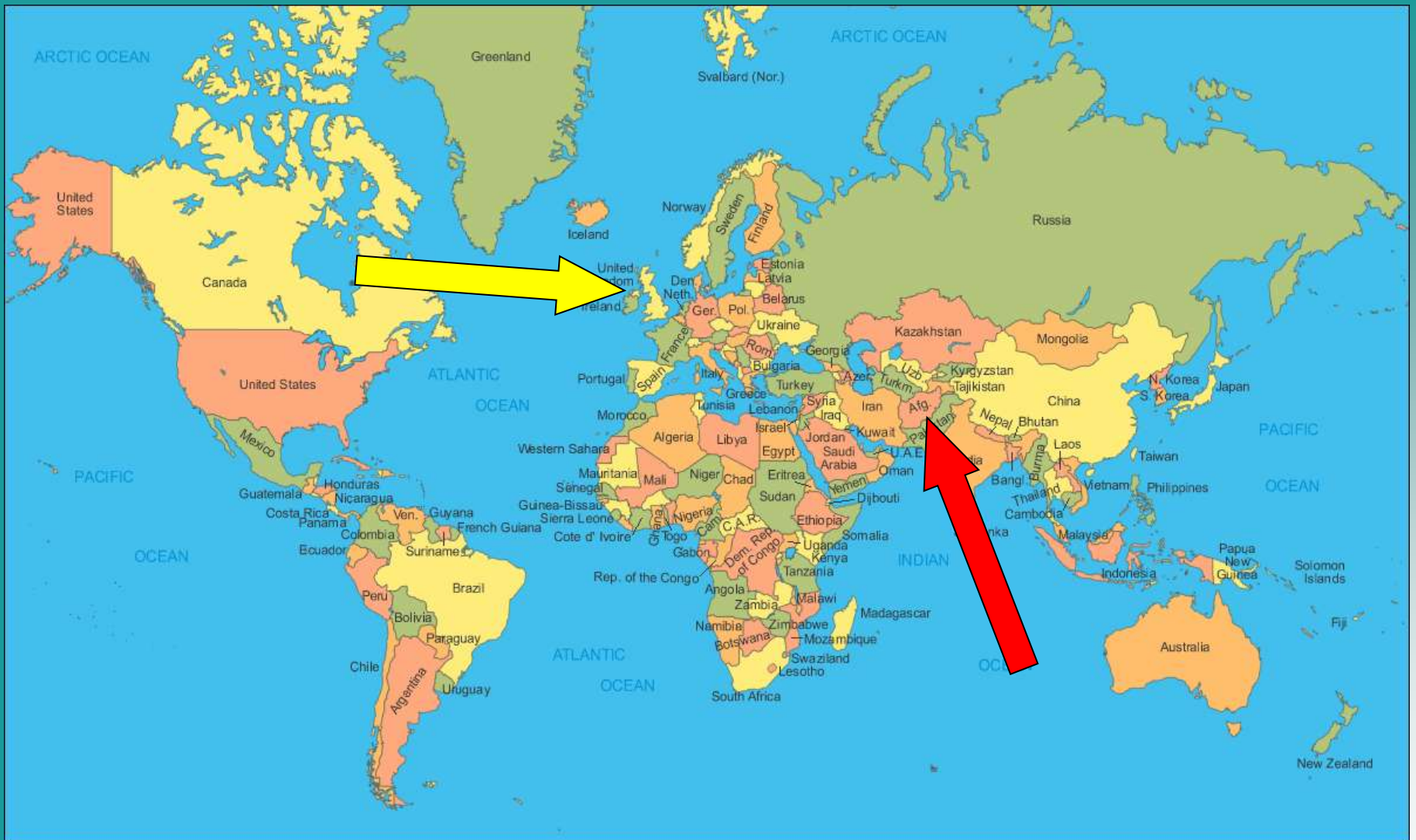


Mina's Story
