# Skiing Update

There are currently 30 children attending after school ski lessons at Polmonhill Ski Centre and it looks as if all wish to continue with their lessons after the Christmas holidays. There is also a short waiting list of children who would like to learn to ski and we are therefore looking to start another 1 or 2 beginners classes in January. If you have children that would like to participate in these classes - either beginners or improvers - then please do get in touch stating which days below would suit best and also whether you can provide a lift.

Beginners: Tuesdays 4-5 pm, Wednesdays 5-6 pm and Fridays 4-5 pm

- it already looks as if the Friday class will be going ahead and there are a few children interested in the Tuesday class but they all require transport to the Ski Centre (some parents finish work in time to collect them at the end of the class)

Improvers (level 3 or higher): Wednesdays 4-5 pm, Fridays 2-3 pm

Improvers (level 5 or higher): Fridays 3-4 pm

The price per lesson is £5.63 (based on the optimum number of 8 or 12 in a class) and includes hire of all ski equipment. We are hoping to keep class sizes to a maximum of 8 to allow for more focused coaching and this may mean that there will be 2 classes running at the same time (in this instance the coaches will split children into age/ability). A smaller class size is possible but this would mean a higher weekly cost though its likely that this would still work out cheaper than the 'normal' lessons.

Following a team from Torphichen Primary School qualifying for the finals of the Scottish Schools Snowsports Association Autumn Dual Slalom Series, it's our intention to enter 1 or more teams in the Alpine Race Series in February 2017. All very exciting for the children.
