P1 Number

Addition to 10

We know there are many ways to make the number 10. When two numbers work together they are called bonds. We will try to learn the bonds to 10.

- write the numbers below on paper and cut them out. 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10 plus another number 5.
- Turn them all face down.
- Pick up one and count on to 10. e.g. If you pick up 7 count on your fingers to 10. 8,9,10. You should have counted out 3 fingers. Do this for all the cards. Can you remember any of the bonds?
- Keep the numbers safe for tomorrow!


