#### 'The Rope Swing' to the end

#### Things to talk about

- Why was Floppy barking? Why does he have a paw over his eyes? Did you notice the fraying rope?
- Look at page 11. If we sound out the word 'What' it does not make sense. If a word does not make sense we need to think what would.
- Look at page 13 and the word 'silly'. There are two consonants. What are they? 1 sound or 2? (just 1)
- Who else sees the fraying rope?
- Look at page 15? What 2 letters do we need for the 'oo' sound in 'looked'?
- What did you think of the ending? Did you get a surprise?

#### 'On the Sand' to the end

#### Things to talk about

- On page 10 find the word 'looked'. What letters make the 'oo' sound?
- Look at the 1<sup>st</sup> word on page 12. Can you sound it out and blend it? What would make sense?
- On page 14, look for the word hiding. What do we need for the 'ng' sound?
- On page 16, what two letters made one sound in the word 'stick'?
- Has anyone played a trick on you? Did you like it?

### Subtraction to 10

- Make 10 scrunched up balls of paper or use 10 Lego brick or something similar. Make sure you have 10 and take 1 away. How many do you have now?
- Carry one taking some away from 10. Can you write out your calculations? They would look like this. 10-1 = 9, 10 - 4 = 6.

- Take the 100 square from the Numeracy Pack and using the wipe clean pen, start at 2 and circle counting up in 2s. Can you see a pattern?
- Count down from 20 in 2s.

### **TOPIC - MAPS**

This week we are going to look at weather maps! Watch the weather forecast at the end of the news as often as possible this week.

### Listening and Talking

- Pay attention to what the weather presenter says and how they speak.
- What listening and talking skills do they use?
- They need to wait until the main news presenter has stopped talking and have a short chat with them, taking turns.
- They need to **speak clearly** and look at the camera to speak to their audience. This is the same as **look at the audience** in a class or when taking to friends.

#### Making a Weather Map

- Look at the symbols the presenter uses.
- Now make your own. Make sure you have windy, rainy, sunny and cloudy. Make as many as you can think of.
- Now write the word under your symbol.
