Spelling

Yesterday we looked at the a_e sound. We will continue with this sound today. Take activity 3 from the Literacy pack.

Activity 3

You should have a sheet with a picture of a cake at the top right.

- There are 7 a_e words at the top with the letter a and e in dots.
- Write the a and e then sound out and blend each word. Remember to use the sound a_e.
- At the middle of the sheet there are 6 words with the a_e sound missing and pictures.
- Fill in the a_e, then sound out and blend each word.
- Draw a ruler line to the matching picture for each word.

P2 Number

Subtraction Split Strategy

We will use the Split strategy for subtraction today. This has been covered in class but children may need reminding.

Children know about Tens and Units and can say how many Tens and Units are in a number.

- Try this. How many Tens in 45? 4
- How many Units in 56? 6
- How many Tens in 78? 7
- How many Units in 23? 3

For subtracting a calculation like this, $45-20$, find out how many Tens there are in $40 = 4$ and 2 in 20. Subtract these 4 Tens - 2 Tens = 2 Tens = 20. Now add the 5. $20+5=25$

Now try these:- $71-60=$ $82-30=$ $46-20=$ $37-20=$

TOO DIFFICULT? Try This for $45-20$. This has also been covered in class.

Using the 100 square find 45 and circle it. Subtract two lots of Tens. Your 100 square might look like this.

Use the Split Strategy for these calculations.

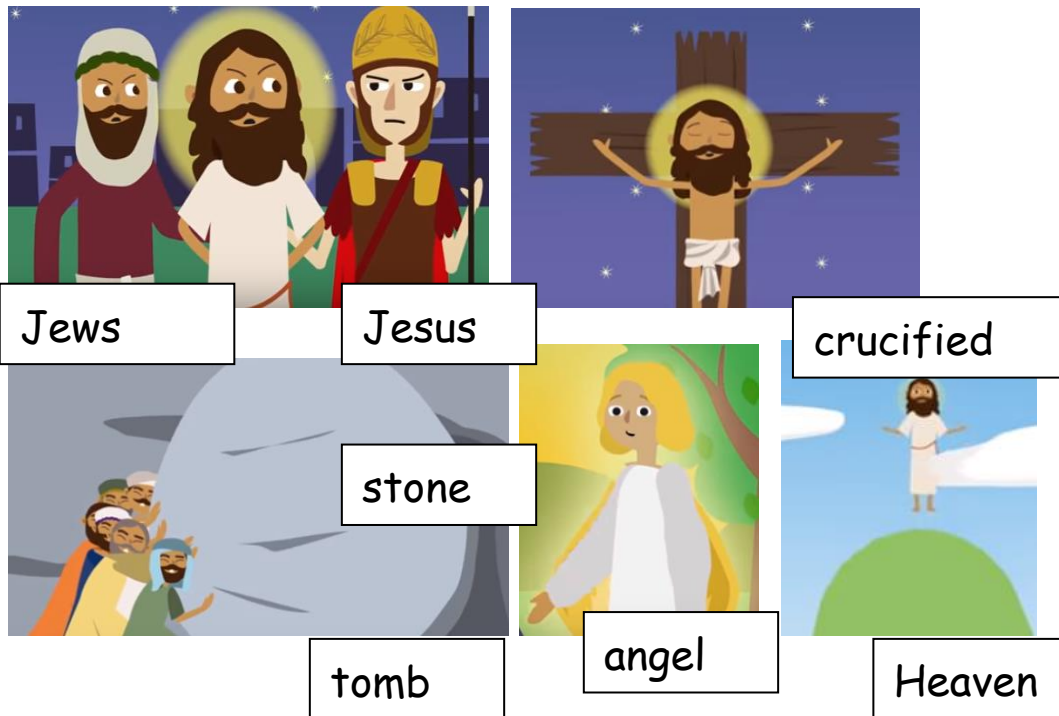
$$250-30= \quad 256-56= \quad 433-21= \quad 589 - 42=$$

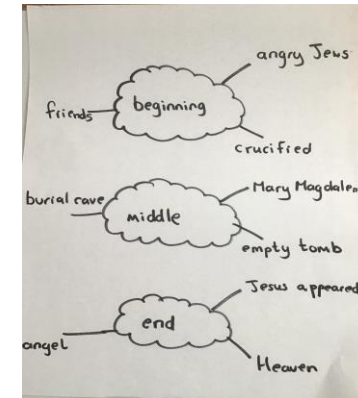

- Include some adjectives. e.g. the enormous stone, the angry Jews, the loyal friends.
