P1 Number

Time and Calendar

- Take out the calendar page for April 2020.
- Put a tick or cross on yesterday's date.
- Did you work out how many weeks we were on holiday? Do you know how many days are in 1 week? There are 7 days in 1 week.
- Have a look at April on your calendar. The first 3 days have no numbers. This means April started on a Wednesday.
- What day did April end on?
- How many spaces are there at the end of the calendar with no date?
- Look along the top of the calendar and you will see the days of the week. They are always in this order. We don't have Monday then Wednesday! The days of the week are the same all over the world! Can you think why?
- Count how many boxes there are from Sunday to Saturday. There are 7 and this makes a week.
- Have a look at March. What day did March start on? What day did March end on?
- Can you find calendars around your home? Have a look and see how they are laid out. Are the same as yours?
