## Spelling Words

We will learn a new sound today. Take a look at the words below. Can you work out the new sound?

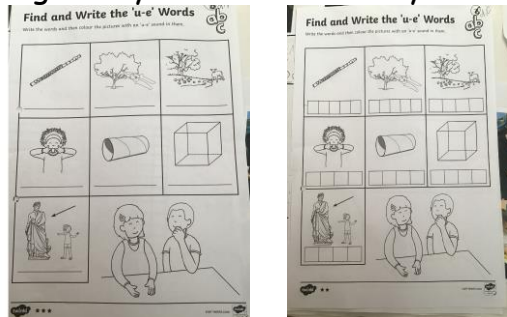
cube tube flute prune

## P2 Number

### Time and Calendar

- Take out the calendar page for April 2020.
- Put a tick or cross on yesterday's date.
- Did you work out how many weeks we were on holiday? Do you know how many days are in 1 week? There are 7 days in 1 week.
- Have a look at March and April on your calendar and find out what day each month started on. Remember the days of the week are along the top and you can find the date (1<sup>st</sup>) then run your finger up the column to find the day.
- Do the same for the last day (March 31<sup>st</sup>, April 30<sup>th</sup>)

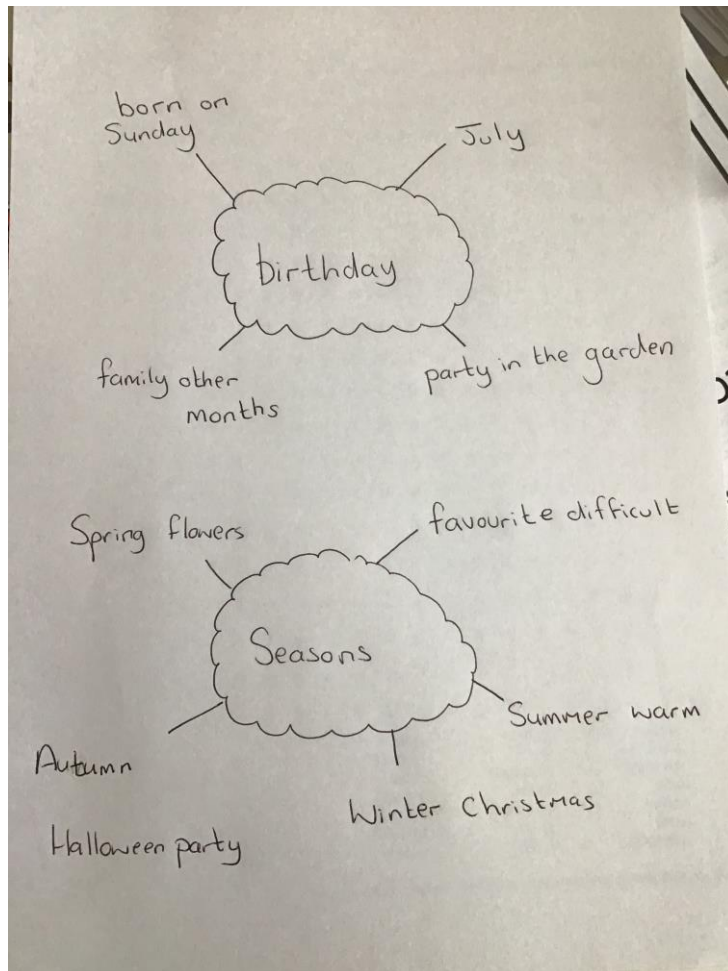
Now look out the calendar for March and April 2019.

- Do the same for March and April. Do the months begin on the same day and end on the same day?
- Can you see a pattern?
- Now find calendars around your home. Have a look and see how they are laid out.

## P2 Writing

Today we will write about time and we are going to write in paragraphs. A paragraph is several sentences about the same thing. You will write at least 2 paragraphs, 1 about your birthday and 1 about Seasons. You may wish to make a mind map to help you organise your ideas.

Use the purple jotter, turn to the next page with a space and lines.  
Remember to put the short date at the top left corner. 21.4.20 To be successful in this lesson you are to

- write at least 2 paragraphs ( 3 or 4 sentences about your birthday and 3 or 4 sentences about the Seasons)
- remember to miss a line when you begin your new paragraph
- use capital letters at the beginning of your sentences, finger spaces and full stops
- sound out and blend the beginning, middle and end of each word you write
