### Things to talk about

- Look at the front cover. Can you find the 'Qu' sound? What 2 letters do you need to make 'Qu'? What 2 letters make 1 sound in Quick? (ck)
- On page 2 and 3, how many times can you find the word quick?
- Can you read the sentences?
- Try to read the sentences on page 4 and 5. Use the pictures for clues.
- Try to read pages 6 to 9 by yourself. Take your time and enjoy reading.

# P1 Reading

#### Things to talk about for all books

- What do you think this book will be about? Look at the front cover and the back cover, can you sound out and blend any of the words?
- What is different from this book and the Kipper books? This is a different genre. It is a non-fiction book.
- Talk about the pictures on each page before working/reading the sentences.

## 'Making a Road' 1 to 7

#### Things to talk about

- Look at the front cover. Can you find the 'ng' sound? What 2 letters do you need to make 'ng'?
- Find the word road. What 2 letters make the 'oa' sound?
- Look at the back cover. Can you read any of the words on the blurb?
- Look at page 1. Can you read the sentence?
- Look at pages 2 and 3. Find the word machines. They
  have a 'ch' sound but this does not make sense so we try
  'sh'.
- On page 4 and 5 can you find the word 'makes'? The a and e work together to make and a\_e sound. The 'a' uses its name not its sound when working with 'e'.
- Try to read the sentences from pages 4 to 7 using the pictures to help with unfamiliar words.

# P1 Number

### Time and Calendar

- Take out the calendar page for April 2020.
- Put a tick or cross on yesterday's date. We are going to look at the days of the week in March and April.
  - First look at March and find the Sunday column.
  - Look down the column and find out how many Sundays there are in March. Each box will need a date in it.
  - Now look at the April calendar and find the Sunday column. How many Sundays are in April? Remember you only count the boxes with a date in them. Which month has more Sundays?
  - Now look at March again and find the Saturday column. How many Saturdays are in March?
  - Now look at April and the Sunday column. How many Sundays are in April?
  - Can you do the same for other days of the week?
