Common Words

Choose and play one of the Common Word Games in the Sounds/Common Words pack. Read the back of the game to find different ways to play. You will find a number spinner in the Number Pack.

Make a list of words you need to work on, no more than 6. Play 'BasketBall' Spelling with someone. To play 'BasketBall' Spelling, 2 players need a list of the words to practice. Player 1 says the first letter, player 2 says the second, player 1 the 3rd until you have said all the letters, then together say the word out loud. If you say the word correctly, you score a point!

Handwriting/Writing

Now practise writing the letter 'Rr'.

Write 3 words that use the 'Rr' sound and draw pictures to match.

Things to talk about

- Look at page 10. Look for the words over and stones. What 2 vowels is use in these words and what sound do they make?
- Look for the words rolls and small on page 10 and 11. Both have 2 consonants but one sound. What are the consonants?
- On page 12 and 13, look for the words paver and makes. If you sound out each letter the word doesn't make sense. You need to look at the whole word and work out which letters work together. The a and e work together to make the letter name sound like when you recite the alphabet. A,B,C......
- On page 15 look for the words painted and lines. Which 2 vowels work together to make their names? ai and i_e
- Look at the last page and find 'Now'. The 'o and w' work together to make the sound, like cow and brow.

Things to talk about

- Look at page 11? Can you find the word that has 2 similar consonants but one sound? buzzes
- Look at page 13 and find the word 'my'. We can't sound out this word so we need to learn it. This is the same for by, try, fly.
- Try to read the rest of the pages by yourself.
- This is a non-fiction book. Can you think of any other non fiction books?

(entertainments), save it, give to charity or a good cause, put it in a bank account and earn interest, lend it to someone.


WHAT DOES IT LOOK LIKE?


