January 1, February 2, March 3, April 4 and May 5.

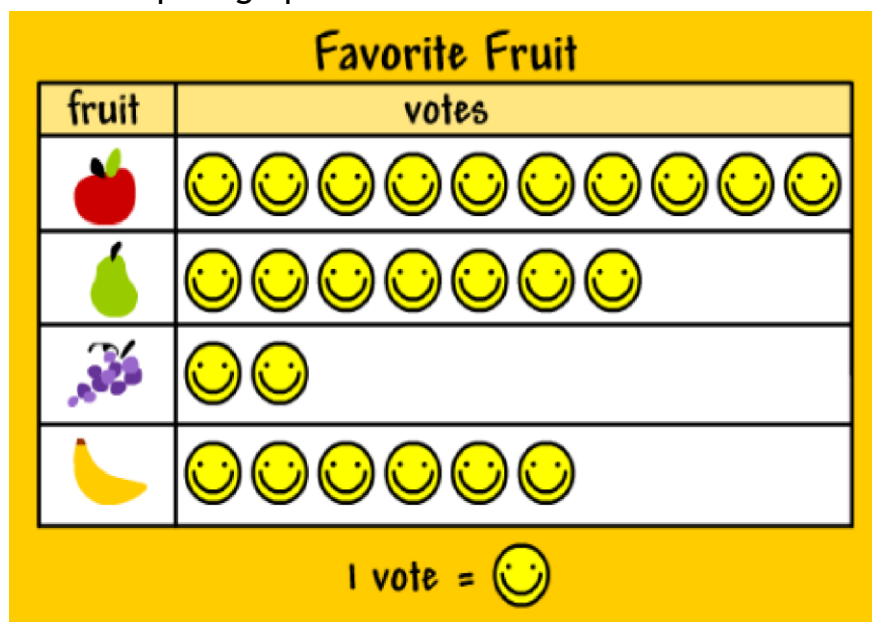
- How many days are in May?

PictoGraph

Today we are going to make a pictograph. This is a graph that uses pictures. You will get to decide what information to collect to put in your pictograph.

Here is a pictograph about favourite fruit.



Things to talk about

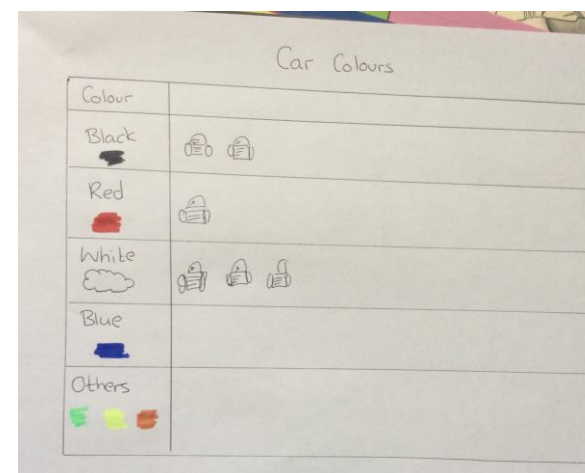
- What is the most favourite fruit?
- What is the least favourite fruit?
- How many people voted for their fruit?
- How many different fruits were voted for?

PictoGraph continued

If you live near a road, you could make a pictograph about the most popular colour of car or the different types of transport you see (cars, busses, bikes, trucks). If you have a garden, you could perhaps look for mini-beasts (ladybirds, worms, wood louse, spiders) or types of birds (blackbird, magpie, crow, blue-tit, robin).

To begin you will need to draw some lines. Use your pink Home Learning jotter. Remember to use a ruler. If you chose car colours it should look like this.



Each little drawing = 1 car. You could sit at your window and draw in the car colours as they go by. Now make up some questions and ask someone in your family to answer them by looking at your pictograph.
