<ul> <li>Play this shape game, on Topmarks: <u>https://www.topmarks.co.uk/early-years/shape-monsters</u></li> <li>Go on a shape hunt. How many different examples can you find of 2D shapes? What is the most common shape?</li> <li>Square</li> <li>Count out some biscuits/sweets/stones. What number did you get up to? Can you get to a higher number, by the end of the week?</li> <li>Give your child socks to put in pairs and ask questions about how many pairs and how many socks in total. Count in 2s and talk about odd and even numbers.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Read the book 'Library Lion' with an adult, and discuss which part of the story is your favourite, and why. <u>https://www.storylineonline.net/books/library-lion/</u> </li> <li>Syllables: Can you find 3 things in your house/garden that have 2 claps in their name? Can you draw pictures of them?</li> <li>Ta/ble</li> <li>How many syllables are there in your own name? Can you clap these out?</li> <li>If you are still struggling to write your name, can you practice writing it properly? (ask an adult to write it, and then you can trace over)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Autumn - Can you find 6 things in your garden/in the park and make an Autumn picture, using all of them?</li> <li>Can you talk to an adult and tell them what the good things are about being back at school?
