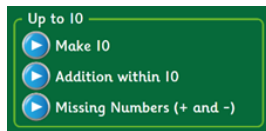
Maths/Numeracy

Storytime - Read the story 'Pumpkin Jack'

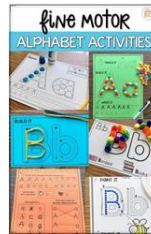
Discuss your favourite part of the story.
