| Maths/Numeracy <br> - With a grown up, make a number line from 1-10, 1-20 or 1-30. Write the numbers in order in a line. Ask a grown up to cover up one of the numbers whilst you close your eyes. We will send new sounds home most Fridays. They will be sent home in an envelope so look out for them and add them to your sound tub! Please keep your sound tubs at home, they do not come back into school. <br> - Make some words with the sounds in your tub. Blend the sounds together to read the words. <br> - Keep practicing the sight words in your tub. <br> - We will send home some information/ images to help you write the first set of letters correctly. Look out for these in your child's bag. You can use them to help your child remember the correct way to form the letters. You can practice writing the letters in sand, shaving foam, paint, chalk etc. <br> - Ask a grown up at home about their favourite children's book. Why do they like it? Who is their favourite character and why? Tell them about your favourite book too. You could phone your grandparents or other family members and ask them what their favourite book was when they were a child.
