



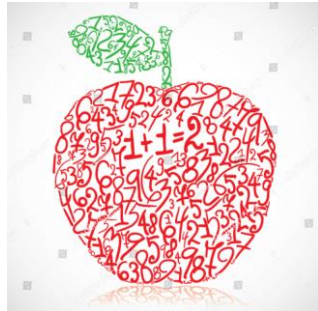
Primary 1 Homework Grid for week beginning 7th December 2020

Maths/Numeracy

- Play the addition game, on Topmarks:

- Make some regular shapes using paper. Use your shapes to make a Christmas picture.
- Complete the Christmas 'cut and paste' activity.
- Practice your number formation of the numbers 1-20. You could use shaving foam/sand/paint.



- Can you make a drawing, using only numbers? Maybe you could make it Christmassy!!

Literacy

- Read the story 'How to catch an Elf' with an adult. Discuss which part of the story is your favourite, and why. Draw a picture of your favourite part. Can you find all the words in the story that rhyme?
