When you are logged in, click on 'Colours' to choose the text and background colours that you feel most comfortable with. Once you have done this, start working through your spelling modules/lessons.</p> <p><u>Orange Group</u></p> <p>Your base word this week is 'sleep'. You now have your word list that you created on Monday for soft start. Practise these words each night using the KS2 Spelling Menu'.
