## What are we learning about this month?

As we move into December the children will be learning about Advent and preparing for Christmas. We are learning about Christmas customs and traditions from our own Scottish culture and those of other countries. We would like to welcome you to share special traditions that are unique to you and your family, by completing the attached sheet with your child.

The Nativity story is the main focus for our learning and celebrations this month. All children will have the opportunity to dress up, if they wish, as one of the Nativity characters and act out the story in our stable. The children will also learn about Christmas in our own Post Office where they will sort and make daily deliveries. Children's art work will be displayed around the centre and we will be learning Christmas songs and listening to Christmas stories.

This year we are acting out the story of Christmas through the Christmas musical play —"Jesus' Christmas party" so our children are learning new songs and musical accompaniments. All the learning experiences above are related directly to curriculum for Excellence covering all areas of learning.



## Christmas Sing-along

As you know, our space for holding special events is limited, but following the success of previous years', we will again host two Singalongs which will allow us to accommodate more people. One for grandparents only and the other for parents/carers. Due to the high



demand for tickets we will offer two tickets per child for both Sing-alongs. Times are noted on the diary section of the newsletter. (Please remember that for reasons of Child Protection no photographs/video recordings can be taken on cameras; phones etc. on the day.) There is no charge for this event, but again this year we will invite you to make a donation to a charity at the Sing-along. You can help us with preparations for this event by singing along with your child to the Christmas songs we will sing on the day. Miss Wilkinson has already sent song sheets home. As our Nativity play is centred around the story of Jesus' Christmas Party, we would like all children to wear their party clothes on the day of the Nativity.

The annual Christmas party for both groups will be help on Monday 22nd December. This takes the form of a traditional children's Christmas party with lots of nice party games, food and fun!

Children are invited to wear something special for the party and we hope that a special visitor will visit with gifts for the children. Normal nursery times apply—please see details of the session outlined on our diary sheet.
