#### Aim

We aim to develop an understanding in children of the importance of practising basic hygiene procedures

# Strategy for Teaching and Learning

We will do this by;

- 1. Teaching and encouraging proper handwashing routines
  - before snack, baking activities and food handling
  - after using the toilet
  - after activities such as planting, feeding the snails etc
- 2. Teaching and encouraging the children by , role modelling, how to take snack:
  - use a clean plate
  - handle only own food, not to handle other pieces of food
  - to dispose of all unwanted food in an appropriate place
  - to properly dispose of food dropped on the floor
- 3. Encourage children how to dispose of tissues, paper towels etc, properly

## **Evaluation and Quality Improvement**

This will be achieved through;

- Continuous observation and monitoring by staff
- Informal liaison and discussion with parents encouraging their support of good practice at home
- Continued health of the children at the nursery
- Reference to current WLC guidelines
- Review of this policy in August 2016
