#### Vision Statement

All children and adults treat each other with mutual respect and consideration in a caring and orderly environment.

#### Our aims are to:

- Encourage our children to:
  - be considerate of other people's feelings and physical comfort;
  - be aware of their own safety and that of other people;
  - take care of their own property and to respect the property of others.
- Encourage staff, parents and other adults involved in the education of our children to:
  - be considerate of other people's feelings and physical comfort;
  - give mutual support in developing strategies to encourage positive behaviour.

## Achieving our aims:

Our aims will be achieved by:

- having boundaries which are consistent, meaningful and understood by the children;
- treating every incident individually whilst ensuring fairness;
- avoiding confrontation eg distract, redirect etc;
- modifying persistent negative behaviour that causes disruption or distress to others by removing the child from the situation and/or providing alternative motivation/distraction;
- working with parents/carers to devise strategies for improving behaviour,
   eg IEPs;

ongoing discussion with staff and parents.

## Making our policy effective:

## We will do so by:

- Sharing with parents and children the behaviour that is considered appropriate for nursery, eg, be kind to others, walk, listen, look after the nursery toys and equipment, use a quiet voice.
- Assessing the policy through -
  - observation of the children's behaviour throughout the year;
  - consultation with staff, parents, other appropriate adults, on the standards we expect and the impact on children's behaviour.
- Updating the policy through -
  - improvements identified as we operate the policy;
  - reviewing it formally once a year.
