### Nursery- Primary One Transition Information for Parents

Below are the dates for transition events planned for all preschool children who have a confirmed primary 1 place at Windyknowe Primary School for August 2016. Parents can opt in or out of as many dates/activities as they wish. We strongly recommend that all children attend on **Monday 13<sup>th</sup> June and Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> of June at least.**

<p>Monday 13<sup>th</sup> June 9:15 am-10:15am</p>	<p><u>Moving on Day 1</u> ALL new primary one children will go round to their new P1 classes with their brand new teachers from 9:15am-10:15am today. <u>Children should arrive at school for 9:15am</u> and line up in the playground at the bottom of the ramp in front of the P1 classrooms (just beside the nursery building in the front playground). Nursery staff will be there to guide everyone on this day and will also accompany the children to make sure that they are happy and settled. During this time parents are asked to go to the school hall to meet Mrs Angus where they will find out about requirements for P1. At 10:15am the children will be brought to the hall to meet back up with their parents. Everyone will be invited to stay for juice and coffee with the P1 teachers.</p>

Moving On Day 2

ALL new primary 1 children will be in school from 8:45am-12:30pm today. Children will be in school over playtime so will need to bring a **SMALL** snack with them. Children should line up in the school playground at the bottom of the P1 ramp (as they did yesterday). P1 teachers will collect children and take them straight into their classrooms where they will spend the full morning with their new friends.

Parents should arrive back to collect their children at 12pm and are invited in to have lunch in the dinner hall with their child in order to see what they will experience in August. Parents should bring a packed lunch for their child to have today.

Parents will be able to speak with staff about school dinners/lunch hall routines. If you are at all unsure whether your child will eat a school dinner this is usually a great chance for you to ask questions about what types of foods they can choose from. The idea of this experience is really so that they get to see what happens in the dinner hall during lunch time. After the summer their super Buddies will be on hand and will go out of their way to keep them right for the first few weeks.
