If your child is going to be absent from nursery, you need to share any information about your child, or have a question/query please phone or email the school office on 01506 280060 or wlcalderwood-ps@westlothian.org.uk. Our nursery champions spend most of their time on the floor supporting, playing and challenging the children during their learning and therefore are unable to take calls directly to the nursery between 8am-4pm. The office champions will pass the messages onto the nursery and a nursery champion will get back to you.
