If your child is later than 8:45am, they should enter the school through the school office. If the PSW champs stay on the gates longer in the mornings, this takes away from their targeted support time. We would encourage all children to be at school for the start time of 8:45am.

We know that we are all human and forget things from time to time, however there are currently a large number of items handed in on a daily basis that are required to be handed on to children. Please try to ensure that children go to school with everything they need for the day.

Primary 1-3 families- please ensure the champion has dismissed everyone from the clan before you approach them for a catch up.
