This could be 2s, 5s, 10s or any sequence that challenges you.</p>	<p><b>Task 4</b></p> <p>Choose a book you have not read before. Use the front cover and blurb to make a prediction about what will happen in the text. Remember to explain what clues you have used to make your prediction!</p>	<p><b>Task 7</b></p> <p>Think of a time you had a fallout with a friend. How did you resolve it and fix the friendship? Show your learning through making a video, poster or any way you choose.</p>	<p><b>Task 9</b></p> <p>Help an adult to cook a meal. What does each ingredient weigh? Share your recipe with us on Seesaw!</p>
<p><b>Task 2</b></p> <p>Create your own concrete materials to show place value. Choose a different material to represent ones, tens and hundreds. Use your concrete materials to partition different numbers.</p>	<p><b>Task 5</b></p> <p><b>Prepare for your clan talk about a special item. We will hear them in class from Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup>. See Seesaw post for more details.</b></p>	<p><b>Task 8</b></p> <p>Speak to an adult about the medicine kept in your house. Find out where it is kept and why it is important to keep it there.</p>	<p><b>Task 10</b></p> <p>Measure objects around your house. Can you find anything that measures exactly:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 1 metre</li> <li>- 10 centimetres</li> <li>- 5 millimetres</li> </ul>
<p><b>Task 3</b></p> <p>Find different 2 or 3 digit numbers around your house. Try to sequence these numbers in the following way:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Smallest to largest</li> <li>-Largest to smallest</li> </ul>	<p><b>Task 6</b></p> <p>Watch an episode of your favourite TV show. Use your summarising skills to retell the story using key points. How short can you make your summary whilst still including the key information?</p>	<p><b>Sumdog</b></p> <p>Complete the Sumdog numeracy challenge you have been set.</p>	<p><b>Language Nut</b></p> <p>Practise listening and talking of greetings and classroom language in French on Language nut.</p>
