<p>Task 1</p> <p>Play this Topmarks game to practice addition and subtraction number families.</p>	<p>Task 4</p> <p>Choose a book and read through it. Are there any words that you don't know the meaning of? How can you clarify the meaning? For example, using clues in the story or using a dictionary.</p>	<p>Task 7</p> <p>Create a poster or record a drama to explain how we can stay safe now that the morning and evenings are getting darker. e.g. Wearing bright clothes.</p>	<p>Task 9</p> <p>When you receive your Read, Write, Count bag, explore the books and activities included in the bag. Share with us how you are using them!</p>
<p>Task 2</p> <p>Roll 2 dice to create a 2-digit number. Roll a third dice and add this number on. Can you show or talk about what strategy you are using? To challenge yourself, roll 4 dice and add 2 2-digit numbers.</p>	<p>Task 5</p> <p>Using one of the sounds we have been learning for spelling, go on a sound walk and find words including this sound. E.g. bike for 'magic e'</p>	<p>Task 8</p> <p>Emotion charades. With a friend or someone at home, pull a face or act out an emotion. Your partner should guess what the emotion is. Can you explain a strategy that you could use when feeling each emotion?</p>	<p>Task 10</p> <p>Talk to an adult at home and find out if they have any interesting stories to share. This could be a story from their culture or religion, their childhood or a story passed through the family.</p>
<p>Task 3</p> <p>What shapes can you find around your home? Organise them into 2D and 3D shapes and name them.</p>	<p>Task 6</p> <p>Edit the template assigned on Seesaw to answer the questions about the picture. Either write or record your answers. Can you explain your thinking?</p>	<p>Sumdog</p> <p>Complete the Sumdog numeracy challenge you have been set.</p>	<p>Language Nut</p> <p>Practise the French number and colour activities assigned to you on Language Nut.</p>
